Our full scope optometric practice has an opportunity for an enthusiastic optometrist to assume a well established, retired practitioner's patient population on a full-time basis (5 days a week). We are the oldest established practice in Yorkton and area. It was originally started in the 1930s and has always consisted of at least two practicing optometrists.

In addition to 5 fully equipped exam lanes, office examination equipment includes Optomap (California model), Topcon OCT, Humphrey Field Analyzer, Nidek auto K-R, FDT visual field screening, Tonometry (NCT, Perkins & Tonopen), and auto Lensometry. Our office utilizes the Clinical Information System (CIS) for computerized billing and reconciliation, appointment scheduling, ordering of ophthalmic eye wear and contact lenses, and recall/appointment reminders. Expansion to EMR in the near future. We currently have over 19 000 active files. We presently employ five full time staff. CCOA staff perform pre-testing on all patients. Very good rapport with local physicians and ophthalmologist as well as ophthalmologists in Regina and Saskatoon. Our dispensary has over 1500 frames on display with an edging lab on site that employs a licensed ophthalmic dispenser. We stock a significant inventory of blank single vision lenses for edging (1-hour service) as well numerous contact lenses (daily and monthly). Eyemaginations patient information system runs throughout the office (exam lanes & patient waiting areas). The office underwent an extensive renovation in July 2017.
